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NEW GAPNA/NGNA Webinar: Updates in Adult-Gero Advanced Practice Nursing (FREE)

This webinar was recorded on February 11, 2014. It discusses updates in adult-gerontological advanced practice nursing and describes the history of gerontological nursing. The roles and scope of practice for the adult-gerontology acute care nurse practitioner, the adult-gerontology primary care nurse practitioner, and the adult-gerontology clinical nurse specialist are explained. The impact and implementation of the APRN Consensus Model on education, certification and licensure for the nurse practitioner and clinical nurse specialist is discussed. Updates on clinical knowledge and skills for gerontological nursing and advanced practice nurses are reported.

This continuing nursing education activity was approved for 0.83 credit hour by the Georgia Nurses Association, an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation.
